DID YOU KNOW?

- The word “fundamentalism” was first used in 1909 by the American protestant church to denote faith foundations priority against the opening to the modern society of the church itself;
- Religions themselves can be sources of expressions and sentiments of prejudice, even though they promote human values of love and tolerance;
- Today religion is increasingly used as a tool to protect the national or cultural identity when it is feared to be in danger.
- The language used in media and public space is often thriving on generalisation and assinging religious meaning where it does not belong. This causes prejudice towards religious people, religions, denominations and churches. Religions are perceived as a threat to a peaceful and inclusive society.

But what do religions have to offer despite prejudice and public opinion? EYCE wants to get to the bottom of this question and scrutinise denominations and religions in Europe carefully, looking at the smallest element constituting religious communities - an individual.
